Recreation Center Entrance Procedure

The health and safety of our employees and our community is top priority for the Town of Manchester. As such, the Town of Manchester is taking actions that are reasonably necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the community and our employees to minimize the effects and limit transmission of COVID-19.

To keep in line with CDC, state and local health department regulations, the Town of Manchester will limit center capacity (subject to change per State of CT guidance). To maintain healthy operations at our facility the following entrance/exit procedures will be instituted:

- All patrons will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms.
- Masks must be worn by all patrons when entering and exiting the facility, when moving to and from common spaces and when unable to safely maintain 6 feet social distancing.
- Social distancing must be maintained while engaging in activities, programs and classes. Masks will be required when unable to maintain social distancing.
- Bathrooms are available. Lockers will not be available for use.
- Centers are not open for drop-in activities.
- Entry and exit traffic patterns will be clearly marked. Please adhere to these patterns.
- Staff will be sanitizing and disinfecting on a regular basis.
- Please use hand sanitizer and remember to wash your hands for at least 20 seconds.
