Spruce Street Market Closures

April 13th, 2020

To All Market Vendors,

The health and safety of our community is top priority for the Town of Manchester. As such, the Town of Manchester has been taking actions that are reasonably necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the community to minimize the effects and limit transmission of COVID-19. In response, the Department of Leisure, Family, and Recreation has canceled all programs indefinitely. We are continuing to assess the situation and will provide program and activity updates as they occur.

In accordance with these guidelines the Division of Neighborhoods and Families has made the difficult decision to cancel all of the Spruce Street Market activities scheduled for the month of June. The decision to close the market was not taken lightly as we know that many of our neighbors look to Spruce Street as a source of healthy foods, fruits, and vegetables.

We are continually evaluating the situation as new information becomes available, decisions on market closures extending beyond the month of June will be made at a later date.

In the meantime we are encouraging community members to look for upcoming video lessons on how to maximize the production of their home gardens, and how-to videos on creating a garden out of commonly available items around your home and yard.
